

How to get to

by road from the NORTH

Approach Middlesbrough travelling South on the A19. After crossing the River Tees turn off on to the A174 and follow signs to Whitby & Scarborough. 5 miles past Guisborough on the A171, at Lockwood Beck Reservoir, turn right for Castleton. Turn left in Castleton and follow signposts to Botton Village.

by TRAIN or BUS

Take main-line train to Darlington and from here the Saltburn train to Middlesbrough. Alternatively, travel by bus to Middlesbrough (London buses depart from Victoria). From Middlesbrough take the Whitby train, getting off at Danby. Trains on this line are very infrequent – please check times with B.R. before travelling. If notified in advance, we will collect you from Danby Station.

by road from the SOUTH

Take the M1, the M18 and A1(M) north. 12 miles north of Ferrybridge take the A64 to York. Pass York on the ring-road, continue on the A64 to the end of the Malton bypass and take the A169 to Pickering. At Pickering turn left onto the A170 towards Helmsley, and just before Kirby Moorside, at Keldholme, turn right to Castleton. Follow this road through Hutton-le-Hole and onto the moors. 3 miles after the Lion Inn there is a short stretch of concrete fencing, and an unmarked road on the right drops down into Botton Village. (If you miss it you will get to Castleton and can follow the signposts!)

by FERRY

From Hull there is a bus from the harbour, via Hull bus station, to Middlesbrough, where you can catch the train. If you are driving, follow roads signs for Beverley and then Malton, and then join the route from the south.

by AIR

From Teeside or Newcastle Airports travel by train to Middlesbrough, and then follow directions as for the train route.
